

## *Fulfilled Prophecies - Jesus as Messiah*

### *- Messiah to be the seed of the woman*

OT *Genesis 3:15* And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel."

NT *Galatians 4:4* But when the fullness of the time was come, God sent forth His Son, made of a woman, made under the law...

### *- Messiah to be the seed of Abraham*

OT *Genesis 12:3* I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

OT *Genesis 18:17,18* And the Lord said, "Shall I hide from Abraham what I am doing, since Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?"

NT *Luke 3:23-34* Now Jesus Himself began His ministry at about thirty years of age, being (as was supposed) the son of Joseph, the son of Heli, the son of Matthat, the son of Levi, the son of Melchi, the son of Janna, the son of Joseph, the son of Mattathiah, the son of Amos, the son of Nahum, the son of Esli, the son of Naggai, the son of Maath, the son of Mattathiah, the son of Semei, the son of Joseph, the son of Judah, the son of Joannas, the son of Rhesa, the son of Zerubbabel, the son of Shealtiel, the son of Neri, the son of Melchi, the son of Addi, the son of Cosam, the son of Elmodam, the son of Er, the son of Jose, the son of Eliezer, the son of Jorim, the son of Matthat, the son of Levi, the son of Simeon, the son of Judah, the son of Joseph, the son of Jonan, the son of Eliakim, the son of Melea, the son of Menan, the son of Mattathah, the son of Nathan, the son of David, the son of Jesse, the son of Obed, the son of Boaz, the son of Salmon, the son of Nahshon, the son of Amminadab, the son of Ram, the son of Hezron, the son of Perez, the son of Judah, the son of Jacob, the son of Isaac, the son of Abraham, the son of Terah, the son of Nahor...

NT *Matthew 1:1* The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham:

NT *Acts 3:25* "...saying to Abraham 'And in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed.'"

NT *Galatians 3:16* Now to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "And to your Seed," who is Christ.

### *- Messiah to be of the tribe of Judah*

OT *Genesis 49:10* The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and to Him shall be the obedience of the people.

NT *Luke 3:33,34 (Luke 3:23-38)* ...the son of Amminadab, the son of Ram, the son of Hezron, the son of Perez, the son of Judah, the son of Jacob, the son of Isaac, the son of Abraham, the son of Terah, the son of Nahor...

NT *Matthew 1:1,2* The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham: Abraham begot Isaac, Isaac begot Jacob, and Jacob begot Judah and his brothers.

### *- Messiah to be the seed of Jacob*

OT *Numbers 24:17,19* I shall see Him, but not now: I shall behold Him, but not nigh: there shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a Scepter shall rise out of Israel, and shall smite the corners of Moab,

and destroy all the children of Sheth. Out of Jacob shall come He that shall have dominion, and shall destroy him that remaineth of the city.

NT **Matthew 1:1,2** The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham: Abraham begot Isaac, Isaac begot Jacob, and Jacob begot Judah and his brothers.

NT **Luke 3:34** ...the son of Judah, the son of Jacob, the son of Isaac, the son of Abraham, the son of Terah, the son of Nahor...

### **- Messiah to be the seed of David**

OT **Psalms 132:11** The Lord hath sworn in truth unto David; He will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne.

OT **Jeremiah 23:5** Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

OT **Isaiah 11:10** And in that day there shall be a Root of Jesse, which shall stand as a banner to the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and His rest shall be glorious.

NT **Matthew 1:6** And Jesse begat David the king; and David the king begat Solomon of her that had been the wife of Uriah;

NT **Luke 1:32,33** He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."

NT **Acts 2:29,30** Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulcher is with us unto this day. Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne;

NT **Romans 1:2,3** ...which He promised before through His prophets in the Holy Scriptures, concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh...

### **- Messiah to be born of a virgin**

OT **Isaiah 7:14** Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.

NT **Matthew 1:18-25** Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit. Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not wanting to make her a public example, was minded to put her away secretly. But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins." So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us." Then Joseph, being aroused from sleep, did as the angel of the Lord commanded him and took to him his wife, and did not know her till she had brought forth her firstborn Son. And he called His name JESUS.

NT **Luke 1:26-35** Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. And having come in, the angel said to her, "Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women!" But when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and considered what manner of greeting this was. Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son,

and shall call His name JESUS. He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end." Then Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I do not know a man?" And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.

**- *Messiah to be a prophet like Moses***

OT **Deuteronomy 18:15,19** "The Lord your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your midst, from your brethren. Him you shall hear, and it shall be that whoever will not hear My words, which He speaks in My name, I will require it of him.

NT **Matthew 21:11** So the multitudes said, "This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth of Galilee."

NT **John 1:45** Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found Him of whom Moses in the law, and also the prophets, wrote--Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph."

NT **John 6:14** Then those men, when they had seen the sign that Jesus did, said, "This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world."

**- *Messiah to be a priest like Melchizedek***

OT **Psalms 110:4** The Lord hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou art a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek. (see Hebrews chapter 7)

NT **Hebrews 5:5,6** So also Christ did not glorify Himself to become High Priest, but it was He who said to Him: "You are My Son, today I have begotten You." As He also says in another place: "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek"

**- *Messiah to be the Son of God***

OT **Psalms 2:7** I will declare the decree: the Lord hath said unto Me, Thou art My Son; this day have I begotten Thee.

OT **Proverbs 30:4** Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? Who hath gathered the wind in His fists? Who hath bound the waters in a garment? Who hath established all the ends of the earth? What is His name, and what is His son's name, if thou canst tell?

NT **Luke 1:32** He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David.

NT **Matthew 3:17** And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

**- *Messiah to be at the right hand of God***

OT **Psalms 110:1** The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit Thou at My right hand, until I make Thine enemies Thy footstool.

NT **Matthew 26:64** Jesus said to him, "It is as you said. Nevertheless, I say to you, hereafter you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming on the clouds of heaven."

NT *Hebrews 1:3* ...who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high...

**- *Messiah as intercessor***

OT *Isaiah 59:16* He saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor, Therefore His own arm brought salvation for Him; And His own righteousness, it sustained Him.

NT *Hebrews 9:15* And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

**- *The new and everlasting Covenant***

OT *Isaiah 55:3,4* Incline your ear, and come unto Me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David. Behold, I have given him for a witness to the people, a leader and commander to the people.  
OT *Jeremiah 31-33* "Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah - not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the Lord. But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

NT *Matthew 26:28* For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

NT *Mark 14:24* And He said to them, "This is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many.

NT *Luke 22:20* Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you.

NT *Hebrews 8:6-13* But the ministry Jesus has received is as superior to theirs as the covenant of which He is mediator is superior to the old one, and it is founded on better promises. For if there had been nothing wrong with that first covenant, no place would have been sought for another. But God found fault with the people and said: "The time is coming, declares the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah. It will not be like the covenant I made with their forefathers when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt, because they did not remain faithful to My covenant, and I turned away from them, declares the Lord. This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time, declares the Lord. I will put My laws in their minds and write them on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be My people. No longer will a man teach his neighbor, or a man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' because they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest. For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more." By calling this covenant "new," He has made the first one obsolete; and what is obsolete and aging will soon disappear.

**- *Messiah is called the Lord***

OT *Jeremiah 23:5,6* Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth. In His days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is His name whereby He shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

NT *Acts 2:36* "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ."

### **- *Mission of the Messiah***

OT *Isaiah 61:1-11* The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent Me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, and provide for those who grieve in Zion - to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair. They will be called oaks of righteousness, a planting of the Lord for the display of His splendor. They will rebuild the ancient ruins and restore the places long devastated; they will renew the ruined cities that have been devastated for generations. Aliens will shepherd your flocks; foreigners will work your fields and vineyards. And you will be called priests of the Lord, you will be named ministers of our God. You will feed on the wealth of nations, and in their riches you will boast. Instead of their shame My people will receive a double portion, and instead of disgrace they will rejoice in their inheritance; and so they will inherit a double portion in their land, and everlasting joy will be theirs. "For I, the Lord, love justice; I hate robbery and iniquity. In My faithfulness I will reward them and make an everlasting covenant with them. Their descendants will be known among the nations and their offspring among the peoples. All who see them will acknowledge that they are a people the Lord has blessed." I delight greatly in the Lord; my soul rejoices in my God. For he has clothed me with garments of salvation and arrayed me in a robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom adorns his head like a priest, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels. For as the soil makes the sprout come up and a garden causes seeds to grow, so the Sovereign Lord will make righteousness and praise spring up before all nations.

NT *Luke 4:16-21* He went to Nazareth, where He had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day He went into the synagogue, as was His custom. And He stood up to read. The scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to Him. Unrolling it, He found the place where it is written: "The Spirit of the Lord is on Me, because He has anointed Me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent Me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." Then He rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant and sat down. The eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fastened on Him, and He began by saying to them, "Today this scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

### **- *The glorious Messiah: Messiah as King***

OT *Isaiah 63:1* Who is this who comes from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah, This One who is glorious in His apparel, traveling in the greatness of His strength?— "I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save."

OT *Psalms 2:6-9* "Yet I have set My King on My holy hill of Zion. I will declare the decree: The Lord has said to Me, "You are My Son, today I have begotten You. Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession. You shall break them with a rod of iron; You shall dash them to pieces like a potter's vessel."

NT *Revelation 19:11-16* Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. And the armies in

heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

***- The coming of the Holy Spirit in the days of the Messiah***

OT **Joel 2:28,29** And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out My Spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out My Spirit.

NT **Acts 2:16-18** But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; And it shall come to pass in the last days, said God, I will pour out of My Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: And on My servants and on My handmaidens I will pour out in those days of My Spirit; and they shall prophesy:

***- Special anointment of the Holy Spirit***

OT **Isaiah 11:2** And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;

OT **Isaiah 42:1** "Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles.

NT **Matthew 3:16,17** When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him. And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

***- Messiah to enter the temple***

OT **Malachi 3:1** "Behold, I send My messenger, and he will prepare the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, will suddenly come to His temple, even the Messenger of the covenant, in whom you delight. Behold, He is coming," says the LORD of hosts.

NT **Matthew 21:12** Then Jesus went into the temple of God and drove out all those who bought and sold in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who sold doves.

***- Messiah's zeal for God***

OT **Psalms 69:9** for zeal for Your house consumes me, and the insults of those who insult You fall on me.

NT **John 2:15-17** When He had made a whip of cords, He drove them all out of the temple, with the sheep and the oxen, and poured out the changers' money and overturned the tables. And He said to those who sold doves, "Take these things away! Do not make My Father's house a house of merchandise!" Then His disciples remembered that it was written, "Zeal for Your house has eaten Me up."

**- Submission of the nations to Messiah's rule**

OT **Isaiah 2:4** And He shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

OT **Micah 4:1-4** But in the last days it shall come to pass, that the mountain of the house of the Lord shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills; and people shall flow unto it. And many nations shall come, and say, Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, and to the house of the God of Jacob; and He will teach us of His ways, and we will walk in His paths: for the law shall go forth of Zion, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem. And He shall judge among many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more. But they shall sit every man under his vine and under his fig tree; and none shall make them afraid: for the mouth of the Lord of hosts hath spoken it.

NT **Revelation 12:5** And she brought forth a man Child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her Child was caught up unto God, and to His throne.

**- The Gentiles shall seek the Messiah of Israel**

OT **Isaiah 11:10** "And in that day there shall be a Root of Jesse, Who shall stand as a banner to the people; For the Gentiles shall seek Him, and His resting place shall be glorious."

NT **Romans 11:25** For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.

**- Opposition of the nations: Messiah's final victory over death**

OT **Psalms 2:2** Why do the nations rage, and the people plot a vain thing? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the Lord and against His Anointed, saying, "Let us break Their bonds in pieces and cast away Their cords from us."

OT **Isaiah 25:8** He will swallow up death forever, and the Lord God will wipe away tears from all faces; The rebuke of His people He will take away from all the earth; For the Lord has spoken.

NT **1 Corinthians 15:54** So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: "Death is swallowed up in victory."

NT **Revelation 19:19** And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army.

NT **Revelation 7:17** And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away."

NT **Revelation 21:4** "And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away."

## **The Suffering Messiah**

### **- The time of Messiah's coming prophesied**

OT **Daniel 9:24-26** Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy. Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times. And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for Himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

NT **Galatians 4:4,5** But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

NT **Ephesians 1:10** that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth - in Him.

### **- Messiah to be preceded by a messenger**

OT **Isaiah 40:3** The voice of one crying in the wilderness: "Prepare the way of the LORD; Make straight in the desert a highway for our God..."

NT **Matthew 3:1,2** In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!"

### **- Bethlehem to be the place of Messiah's birth**

OT **Micah 5:2** "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of you shall come forth to Me the One to be Ruler in Israel, whose goings forth are from of old, from everlasting."

NT **Matthew 2:1,2** Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, saying, "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him."

NT **Luke 2:4-6** Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, to be registered with Mary, his betrothed wife, who was with child. So it was, that while they were there, the days were completed for her to be delivered.

### **- Messiah will be meek and mild**

OT **Isaiah 42:2,3** He will not shout or cry out, or raise His voice in the streets. A bruised reed He will not break, and a smoldering wick He will not snuff out. In faithfulness He will bring forth justice;

OT **Isaiah 53:7** He was oppressed and afflicted, yet He did not open His mouth; He was led like a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so He did not open His mouth.



NT **Matthew 12:17-20** This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: "Here is My servant whom I have chosen, the One I love, in whom I delight; I will put My Spirit on Him, and He will proclaim justice to the nations. He will not quarrel or cry out; no one will hear His voice in the streets. A bruised reed He will not break, and a smoldering wick He will not snuff out, till He leads justice to victory.

NT **Matthew 26:62,63** Then the high priest stood up and said to Jesus, "Are you not going to answer? What is this testimony that these men are bringing against You?" But Jesus kept silent. And the high priest answered and said to Him, "I put You under oath by the living God: Tell us if You are the Christ, the Son of God!"

**- Galilee to be the first area of Messiah's ministry**

OT **Isaiah 9:1,2** Nevertheless the gloom will not be upon her who is distressed, as when at first He lightly esteemed the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, and afterward more heavily oppressed her, by the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, in Galilee of the Gentiles. The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in the land of the shadow of death, upon them a light has shined.

NT **Matthew 4:12-16** Now when Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, He departed to Galilee. And leaving Nazareth, He came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the regions of Zebulun and Naphtali, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, by the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles: The people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, and upon those who sat in the region and shadow of death Light has dawned."

**- Messiah will Minister to the Gentiles**

OT **Isaiah 42:1** "Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles.

OT **Isaiah 49:5,6** "And now the Lord says, who formed Me from the womb to be His Servant, to bring Jacob back to Him, so that Israel is gathered to Him (For I shall be glorious in the eyes of the Lord, and My God shall be My strength), Indeed He says, 'It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved ones of Israel; I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles, that You should be My salvation to the ends of the earth.'"

NT **Matthew 12:21** "And in His name Gentiles will trust."

NT **Acts 13:47,48** For so the Lord has commanded us: "I have set you as a light to the Gentiles, that you should be for salvation to the ends of the earth." Now when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and glorified the word of the Lord. And as many as had been appointed to eternal life believed.

**- Messiah will perform miracles**

OT **Isaiah 35:5,6** Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. Then the lame shall leap like a deer, and the tongue of the dumb sing. For waters shall burst forth in the wilderness, and streams in the desert.

NT **John 11:47** Then the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered a council and said, "What shall we do? For this Man works many signs.

NT **Matthew 9:35** Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

NT **Matthew 11:2-6** And when John had heard in prison about the works of Christ, he sent two of his disciples and said to Him, "Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?" Jesus answered and said to them, "Go and tell John the things which you hear and see: the blind see and the lame walk; the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them. And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me."

**- *Messiah will enter Jerusalem on a donkey***

OT **Zechariah 9:9** "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, lowly and riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey."

NT **Matthew 21:1-11** And when they drew nigh unto Jerusalem, and were come to Bethphage, unto the mount of Olives, then sent Jesus two disciples, saying unto them, go into the village over against you, and straightway ye shall find an ass tied, and a colt with her: loose them, and bring them unto Me. And if any man say ought unto you, ye shall say, the Lord hath need of them; and straightway he will send them. All this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying, tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass. And the disciples went, and did as Jesus commanded them, and brought the ass, and the colt, and put on them their clothes, and they set Him thereon. And a very great multitude spread their garments in the way; others cut down branches from the trees, and spread them in the way. And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the son of David: Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest. And when He was come into Jerusalem, all the city was moved, saying, Who is this? So the multitudes said, "This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth of Galilee."

**- *Messiah to be betrayed by a friend***

OT **Psalms 41:9** Even my close friend, whom I trusted, he who shared My bread, has lifted up his heel against Me.

NT **John 13:18,21** "I am not referring to all of you; I know those I have chosen. But this is to fulfill the scripture: 'He who shares My bread has lifted up his heel against Me.' After He had said this, Jesus was troubled in spirit and testified, "I tell you the truth, one of you is going to betray Me."

**- *Messiah will be forsaken by His disciples***

OT **Zechariah 13:7** "Awake, O sword, against My Shepherd, against the Man who is My Companion," Says the Lord of hosts. "Strike the Shepherd, and the sheep will be scattered; then I will turn My hand against the little ones.

NT **Matthew 26:31,56** Then Jesus said to them, "All of you will be made to stumble because of Me this night, for it is written "I will strike the Shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered.' But all this was done that the Scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled." Then all the disciples forsook Him and fled.

**- *Messiah to be hated without a cause***

OT **Psalms 69:4** "Those who hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of my head; They are mighty who would destroy me, being my enemies wrongfully..."

NT **John 15:25** But this happened that the word might be fulfilled which is written in their law, "They hated Me without a cause."

**- Messiah to be wounded and bruised**

OT **Isaiah 53:5** But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.

NT **Matthew 27:26** Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered Him to be crucified.

**- Messiah will be smitten**

OT **Isaiah 50:6** I gave My back to those who struck Me, and My cheeks to those who plucked out the beard; I did not hide My face from shame and spitting.

NT **Matthew 26:67** Then they spat in His face and beat Him; and others struck Him with the palms of their hands,

NT **Matthew 27:26,30** Then he released Barabbas to them; and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered Him to be crucified. Then they spat on Him, and took the reed and struck Him on the head.

**- Messiah to be mocked**

OT **Psalms 22:7,8** All who see Me mock Me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads: "He trusts in the LORD; let the LORD rescue Him. Let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him."

NT **Matthew 27:31** And when they had mocked Him, they took the robe off Him, put His own clothes on Him, and led Him away to be crucified.

**- Messiah to be crucified with thieves**

OT **Isaiah 53:12** Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong, because He poured out His soul unto death, and He was numbered with the transgressors, and He bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

NT **Matthew 27:38** Then were there two thieves crucified with Him, one on the right hand, and another on the left.

NT **Luke 23:33** And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other on the left.

**- Messiah to experience crucifixion**

OT **Psalms 22:14-18** I am poured out like water, and all My bones are out of joint: My heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of My bowels. My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and My tongue cleaves to My jaws; and thou hast brought Me into the dust of death. For dogs have compassed Me: the assembly of the wicked have enclosed Me: they pierced My hands and My feet. I can count all My bones: they look and stare upon Me. They part My garments among them, and cast lots upon My vesture.

OT **Psalms 69:21** They gave me also gall for my meat; and in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.

NT **Matthew 27:34-50** They gave Him vinegar to drink mingled with gall: and when He had tasted thereof, He would not drink. And they crucified Him, and parted His garments, casting lots: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, They parted My garments among them, and upon My vesture did they cast lots. And sitting down they watched Him there; And set up over His head His accusation written, THIS IS JESUS THE KING OF THE JEWS. Then were there two thieves crucified with Him, one on the right hand, and another on the left. And they that passed by reviled Him, wagging their heads, and saying, thou that would destroy the temple, and rebuild it in three days, save thyself. If thou be the Son of God, come down from the cross. Likewise also the chief priests mocking Him, with the scribes and elders, said, He saved others; Himself He cannot save. If He be the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe Him. He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now, if He will have Him: for He said, I am the Son of God. The thieves also, which were crucified with Him, reviled Him. Now, from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour. And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, My God, why hast thou forsaken Me? Some of them that stood there, when they heard that, said, This man calls for Elias. And straightway one of them ran, and took a sponge, and filled it with vinegar, and put it on a reed, and gave Him to drink. The rest said, Let be, let us see whether Elias will come to save Him. Jesus, when He had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost.

NT **John 19:28-30** After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, said, I thirst. Now there was set a vessel full of vinegar: and they filled a sponge with vinegar, and put it upon hyssop, and put it to His mouth. When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, He said, It is finished: and He bowed His head, and gave up the ghost.

**- Messiah to suffer, die and rise again**

OT **Isaiah 52:13,14** See, My servant will act wisely; He will be raised and lifted up and highly exalted. Just as there were many who were appalled at you, His appearance was so disfigured beyond that of any man and His form marred beyond human likeness-

OT **Isaiah 53:12** Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong, because He poured out His soul unto death, and He was numbered with the transgressors, and He bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

NT **Matthew** – chapters **27,28** **Mark** – chapters **15,16** **Luke** – chapters **23,24** **John** – chapters **19,20**  
-Messiah to be raised from the dead

**- Messiah garments parted and lots cast**

OT **Psalms 22:18** They divide My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots.

NT **John 19:23,24** Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments and made four parts, to each soldier a part, and also the tunic. Now the tunic was without seam, woven from the top in one piece. They said therefore among themselves, "Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be," that the Scripture might be fulfilled which says: "They divided My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots."

**- Messiah's forsaken cry**

OT **Psalms 22:1** My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?...

NT **Matthew 27:46** And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?"

**- Messiah commits Himself to God**

OT **Psalms 31:5** Into Your hand I commit my spirit;

NT **Luke 23:46** And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice, He said, "Father, "into Your hands I commit My spirit." Having said this, He breathed His last.

**- Messiah will be pierced**

OT **Zechariah 12:10** "And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced. Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son, and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn."

OT **Psalms 22:16** For dogs have surrounded Me; the congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet;

NT **John 19:34,37** But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out. And again another Scripture says, "They shall look on Him whom they pierced."

**- Messiah's bones will not be broken**

OT **Psalms 34:20** He guards all his bones; Not one of them is broken.

NT **John 19:33** But when they came to Jesus and saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs.

**- Darkness over the land**

OT **Amos 8:9** "In that day," declares the Sovereign LORD , "I will make the sun go down at noon and darken the earth in broad daylight.

NT **Matthew 27:45** Now from the sixth hour until the ninth hour there was darkness over all the land.

**- Messiah to be raised from the dead**

OT **Psalms 16:10** For You will not leave my soul in Sheol, nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.

NT **Acts 13:35-37** Therefore He also says in another Psalm: "You will not allow Your Holy One to see corruption." For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God, fell asleep, was buried with his fathers, and saw corruption; but He whom God raised up saw no corruption."

**- Messiah's ascension**

OT **Psalms 68:18** You have ascended on high, You have led captivity captive; ...

NT **Acts 1:9** Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight.

**- *Messiah, the stone which the builder rejected, to become the head cornerstone***

OT ***Psalm 118:22,23*** The stone which the builders rejected, has become the chief cornerstone. This was the Lord's doing; It is marvelous in our eyes.

OT ***Isaiah 8:13-15*** The Lord Almighty is the One you are to regard as holy, He is the One you are to fear, He is the One you are to dread, and He will be a sanctuary; but for both houses of Israel He will be a stone that causes men to stumble and a rock that makes them fall. And for the people of Jerusalem He will be a trap and a snare. Many of them will stumble; they will fall and be broken, they will be snared and captured."

OT ***Isaiah 28:16*** Therefore thus says the Lord God: "Behold, I lay in Zion a stone for a foundation, a tried stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation; Whoever believes will not act hastily.

NT ***Matthew 21:42,43*** Jesus said to them, "Have you never read in the Scriptures: 'The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone. This was the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes'? "Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a nation bearing the fruits of it."

NT ***Acts 4:11,12*** This is the "stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone.' Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

NT ***Romans 9:32,33*** but Israel, pursuing the law of righteousness, has not attained to the law of righteousness. Why? Because they did not seek it by faith, but as it were, by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumbling stone. As it is written. "Behold, I lay in Zion a stumbling stone and rock of offense, and whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."

NT ***Ephesians 2:20*** Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

NT ***1 Peter 2:6-8*** For in Scripture it says: "See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in Him will never be put to shame." Now to you who believe, this stone is precious. But to those who do not believe, "The stone the builders rejected has become the capstone," and, "A stone that causes men to stumble and a rock that makes them fall." They stumble because they disobey the message - which is also what they were destined for.
